CALL offers four membership levels.

Membership Levels and Dues

Active	Works with legal information in a library or information center or provides library services on an independent contract basis	\$35.00
Associate	Not eligible for Active membership status, includes non-library workers in the information industry or members of library governing boards	\$70.00
Student	Enrolled in a degree program related to law librarianship. Limited to five consecutive years	\$10.00
Retired	Retired from library work and was an active member of CALL for at least ten consecutive years	\$10.00

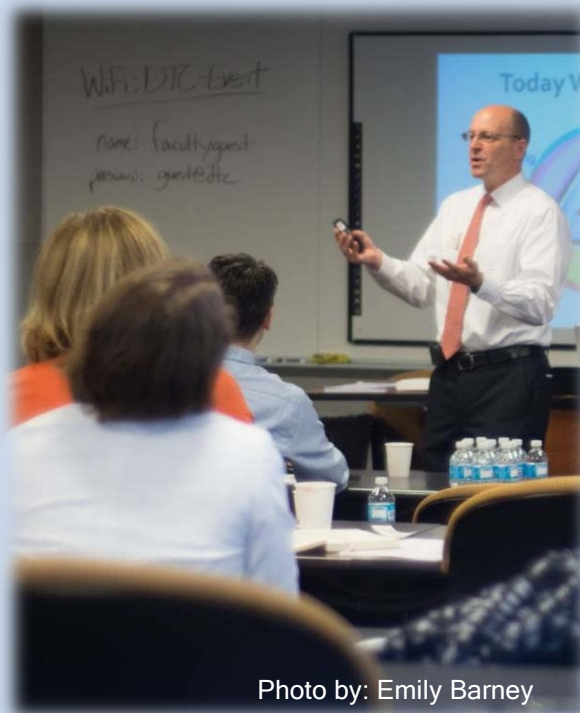
